## TERMS TO REMEMBER: HAIR & MAKE-UP

### 1 Wig

A headpiece made from real or fake hair, worn by actors to change their hairstyle or colour. Wigs are used to create specific looks or styles for a character



### 2 Hairpiece

A small section of hair, like extensions, buns, or braids, used to add volume or create specific styles without needing a full wig.

### 3 Pomade

A styling product used to add texture or shine to hair, often used to slick back hair or create hairstyles from specific time periods.



### 4 Teasing

A method where hair is combed toward the head to create volume and fullness, often used for dramatic or old-fashioned hairstyles.

### 5 Stage Makeup

A heavier type of makeup specifically designed for use under stage lighting, which can wash out regular makeup. It helps to make facial features visible from a distance.



### 6 Contour & Highlight

Makeup technique used to shape the face. Contour creates shadows to define areas like cheekbones, jawline, and nose, while highlighting brightens certain areas to make features stand out.



### 7 Spirit Gum

A type of sticky glue-like material used to attach prosthetics, fake facial hair, and other special makeup effects to the skin.



### 8 Prosthetics

Specially-made pieces, like fake noses, scars, or wounds, that are glued to the actor's face or body to create a physical transformation.
