TERMS TO REMEMBER: COSTUMES

1 Costume

The full outfit worn by an actor to become a character. This includes clothing, accessories, shoes, and sometimes special makeup or wigs.



2 Wardrobe

Refers to the entire collection of costumes used in a production, as well as the team responsible for maintaining, repairing, and organising them.



3 Quick Change

A fast costume change that must be completed in a short amount of time, often with the help of wardrobe crew members. Quick-change areas are set up near the stage to make the changes quicker.



4 Fittings

Times when actors try on costumes so that the costume designer and wardrobe team can adjust them to fit well and feel comfortable.



5 Period Costume

Costumes made to look like clothing from a specific time in history, using fabrics, shapes and styles from that time period.
